



Extension of
the Technical Memorandum of Understanding between
The Institute of Veterinary Drug Control of the People's Republic of China
and
the Agency for Veterinary Medicinal Products,
French agency for food, environmental and occupational health safety, France

Considering the Technical memorandum of Understanding signed on November 17th 2010 between the General Director of the Institute of Veterinary Drug Control of the People's Republic of China and the Director of the Agency for Veterinary Medicinal Products, French agency for food, environmental and occupational health safety, France;

Considering that this memorandum allowed establishing real links of cooperation between the two parties in all matters relating to veterinary medicinal products as well as professional exchanges of quality between teams;

Considering that the memorandum remained in force during five years;

Considering its article 5 which indicates that *"the period of validity of this memorandum may be extended by written consent of both parties"*;

The two parties agree to extend the validity of the memorandum, as a follow-up to the progress already made in recent years. The memorandum will remain in force for the next five years.

This written consent is signed in Maisons Alfort, on November the 18th of 2015.
